

## Village Green Swimming Pool Regulations

### **General:**

1. The lifeguard on duty is in charge of the pool and is responsible to the Lifeguard Safety Supervisor, who in turn is responsible to the swimming pool chairpersons of the Village Green Homeowners Association. Any of the above mentioned people have the authority to revoke pool privileges for the day for any violation of these pool regulations. Complaints should be referred to the Lifeguard Safety Supervisor, to the HOA Pool Chairs, or to the Board of Directors.
2. No one is allowed inside the fenced pool area when the gates are locked. Appropriate penalties for violators/trespassers will be determined by the HOA Pool Chairs, or the Board of Directors or the Sherriff's Department, if summoned
3. Members and immediate family who are current in their annual assessment or have paid a non-resident recreation fee may use the pool and facilities in accordance with the published schedule.
4. Use of the swimming pools will be permitted only when a lifeguard, hired by the Village Green Homeowners Association is on duty.
5. Each person entering the pool area must show their Pool Pass to a lifeguard and sign in with their last name, current Pool Pass number, number of adults and children in their party and an emergency contact phone number. NO EXCEPTIONS.
6. In the case of repeat offenders, or when violations are sufficiently serious so that pool privileges are suspended for more than a day, the individual must appear before the HOA Pool Chairs, or to the Board of Director before his/her privileges will be reinstated. If the individual is a minor, he/she must be accompanied by a parent.
7. No alcoholic beverages will be permitted in the pool area.
8. Glass items and pets are not permitted within the fenced area.
9. Bicycles are to stay outside of the fenced area.
10. Pools, restrooms and pool decks are No Smoking areas.
11. There is NO DIVING or running permitted at either pool.
12. No loitering in the parking lots is permitted after dusk or after the pool closes.

### **Guests:**

1. Guests must be accompanied by a Village Green member.
2. Out-of-town guests living more than fifty miles from Village Green will not be charged a fee, but must be accompanied by a Village Green member.
3. Other guests will be charged a fee at the rate of three dollars (\$3) per guest per day. All fees are to be paid to the lifeguard at the time the guests sign in.
4. Lifeguard Safety Supervisor approval is required for more than 5 guests.
5. The both pools are available for parties. Hosts must pay for a lifeguard when using a pool during regularly scheduled non-operating times. Contact our HOA pool chairs.

### **Age Limitations:**

1. Children under ten (10) years of age must be accompanied at all times by a person sixteen (16) years of age or older who will be responsible for the conduct of the child.
2. Children over ten (10) years of age may swim without an accompanying adult provided that the child can demonstrate to the satisfaction of the lifeguard on duty that he/she can swim the length of the pool and is safe in the water.
3. The use of the Baby (wading) Pools is limited to children ages 6 years old and under.
4. Children requiring diapers must wear swim diapers.
5. Children in the Baby Pool and non-swimmers must be supervised by an adult at all times.

### **Hours of Operation:**

The hours of operation can be found on the Village Green Web Site and posted at both pools

1. The pool may be closed because of inclement weather at the discretion of the lifeguards on duty.
2. The pools will be closed for 15 minutes following the last audible thunder clap and 30 minutes after the last visible lightning. The pool deck must be cleared for lightning.
3. If mechanical or water chemistry difficulties necessitate the temporary closing of a pool, a notice of that fact will be posted and will indicate when the pool will reopen.
4. Pools will be closed 10 minutes every hour for adult swim and lifeguard break.
